ISHRAE - Student Chapter Formation - Frequently Asked Questions

What is ISHRAE?

ISHRAE [Indian Society of Heating Ventilating & Air Conditioning Engineers] is non-profit organization which remains in service for the HVACR community & has the following objectives:

- 1. Advancement of Sciences of HVACR and related Sciences.
- **2.**Continuing Education of Members/others thru Lectures, Demos & Publications.
- 3. Rendition of Career Guidance & Financial Assistance to Students.
- 4. Encouragement of Scientific Research.

To further these objectives, ISHRAE organizes Exhibitions like ACREX & COMFEX, Technical Seminars, Technical Lectures etc. Specially for the students ISHRAE encourages the formation of 'Student Chapters' & organizes special events for such chapters such as Project Competitions, Technical Seminars, Placement Assistance, Paper Presentation Competitions etc.

What is ASHRAE?

ASHRAE - [American Society of Heating Ventilating & Air Conditioning Engineers] is the World-Wide Society most popularly known for its 'Handbooks' & also for its Monthly Journals & AHR Expo The Annual International Exhibition. ISHRAE is affiliated society of ASHRAE in India.

What is a Student Chapter?

An ISHRAE student chapter can be formed at any Engineering Institute having a minimum 3 year course having HVACR / Thermodynamics as a subject. Minimum 20 students are needed to form a student chapter. Atleast one [preferably two] staff members are needed to act as 'Chapter Coordinators'. These chapter coordinators should be ISHRAE members.

ISHRAE Pune can have student chapters for colleges in Pune / Aurangabad / Nashik / Kolhapur & other areas. Colleges in Mumbai / Nagpur should approach the local ISHRAE chapter in these areas.

What are the benefits of forming a student chapter?

Other than having a well equipped **Library** ISHRAE chapters conduct **monthly technical programs**, which the student members can attend **free** of cost.

Sponsored programs & seminars are **heavily subsidized** for student members, enabling them to get a professional exposure at extremely low costs.

ISHRAE publishes a **QUARTERLY JOURNAL** priced at Rs.125+. This excellent quality journal is **available FREE for all student chapter members** and is couriered to all student chapter co-ordinators for further distribution.

Events like **TechnoCHILL**, **which are exclusive for student** are almost free for student members. The benefits of attending such events &/or participating in them is highlighted on the reverse.

ISHRAE being a society of professional engineers, student members can **interact** closely with such members, which can help in tremendously in terms of **career guidance, project ideas, industrial visits, placements etc.**

What are fees for student members?

Each student member pays an **annual fee of Rs.350/-** towards the membership.

What is the procedure for student chapter formation?

Standard **application forms** are available from ISHRAE and/or with your faculty members. Forms **duly filled** with the membership fees should be handed over to the chapter co-ordinator of your college. Whenever you have 20+ applications a separate chapter of the college can be formed. ISHRAE shall then formally register your chapter and issue a 'Charter'.
